## 2009 Autumn International Lake of Menteith - 11th September 2009

The Autumn International week started off badly with very wet and windy conditions but improved quickly to give good conditions on competition day.

The Scottish Team put in a magnificent performance to boat 108 trout which was 34 trout more than any of their competitors. Their weight of 229lb 13.2oz was 68lb 15oz better than their nearest rival, England, who were second.

The Brown Bowl for the top rod on the day was **Andy McKay** with 11 trout for 23lb 01oz and Scotland had the top four individual rods with **Erlend Hutchison**, **Sandy McConnachie** and **Ken Oliver** being 2nd, 3rd and 4th. Three other Scottish rods, **Andy Dunn**, **Campbell Morgan** and **Jim McBride** were also in the top 10.
