They also wish to thank all of the fisheries that hosted the heats and semis and particularly OTFA for managing the Harray heat and the Lake of Menteith for hosting the final and providing pies for the competitors and boatmen at the end of the session. The committee are also grateful to Ian Colligan for standing in as a port angler and fish weigher on numerous occasions and usually at short notice and also wish to thank the thirty three boatmen who gave up their Saturday to ensure the success off the final.

The competitors had cloud cover for almost all the session and although it was on the chilly side the wind was light and only really picked up late on as the sun broke through. From the outset the boats were well spread out with anglers to be seen in most parts of the Lake. During the afternoon the majority of the boats were in open water at the eastern end.

The top eighteen rods from the final qualified for the the 2025 international teams to represent Scotland at Rutland and Menteith and with eleven members of the 2024 gold medal teams and seven previous national champions taking part it was never going to be an easy task.

Top rod with 17 fish for 36lb 6.5oz was Ronnie Gilbert of Greys Menteith Ospreys. In addition to receiving the trophy Ronnie also received a £300 voucher provided by Fishers Direct. Ronnie has won the trophy twice before in 2008 and 2014 and was also second in 2017. He was in the gold medal team at the 2024 autumn international and won the brown bowl for the top individual at internationals in 2022 and 2023.

In second place with 15 fish for 30lb 0.1oz was Ben Robertson of Tartan Tyers and he received a voucher for £100 provided by Fishers Direct. Ben was also in the gold medal team at the 2024 autumn international. In third place with 13 fish for 29lb 3.4oz was Gregor Fleming of Albacats and he received a voucher for £100 provided by Fishers Direct. Gregor was in the gold medal team at the 2024 spring international.

Semi-Final No 5 - Menteith 28th June 2024

The fifth and last of the semi-finals was held at the Lake of Menteith on Friday 28th June. Once again it was a chilly day with a strong and blustery west wind which grew in strength as the session progressed. It was overcast with occasional showers for most of the day with the sun breaking through later in the day. Thirty anglers took part and between them they caught 353 fish of which four were over 4lbs. The top 14 rods qualified for the final and 12 fish were needed to get through.



Top rod with 29 fish for 60lb 0.4oz was Peter Auchterlonie of Greys Menteith Ospreys. Peter took almost all of his fish in Cages Bay where he was fishing fabs and diawl bachs on a midge tip line.

In second place with 22 fish was Martin McCafferty of Future FF and third place went to Ronnie Gilbert also of Greys Menteith Ospreys,

The fourth semi-final was held at Harelaw on Friday 21st June and once again the anglers had to contend with a chilly breeze. It was overcast throughout the day with fish showing in most areas but were proving hard to tempt with several anglers reporting that they were attracting fish but couldn't hook them. Some competitors did well in the morning but as the temperature dropped so did the number of fish being caught. There were 30 anglers taking part and between them they caught 161 trout. The top fourteen rods qualified for the final and 5 fish were needed to get through.



Top rod with 10 fish for 20lb 9.10oz was Calum Clark of Firecats. Colin took his fish on dries. In second place with 10 fish for 19lb 15.3oz was James Simpson of Dounreay who took his fish pulling boobies and foam daddies. Brian Fletcher of Kilbirnie AC was third with 10 fish for 19lb 11.6oz and Brian also took his fish on dries.

The third semi-final was held at the Lake of Menteith on Tuesday 18th June and for once there was warmth in the air. It was overcast for most of the session with a light breeze although the sun broke through late in the afternoon. There were 37 anglers taking part and between them they caught 267 trout. The top seventeen rods qualified for the final and 7 fish were needed to get through.

Top rod was Robbie Gibson of Balforn Piscatorials who netted 19 fish for 39lb 6.9oz. Robbie took his fish on cormorants and dries at International Bay, Hotel Bay and Cages Bay. Alan Steven of Tartan Tyers was second with 13 fish for 28lb 0.7oz and the defending champion, Derek Pozz, was third with 13 fish for 26lb 14.9oz

Heat 8 - Harray Loch 26th May

It's that time of year again where the road to winning a place in the Scottish Fly Fishing teams begins with the Harray Qualifier on Sunday 26th of May.

23 anglers contested the Harray heat with a good representation made from anglers outwith Orkney. Great to see anglers from Shetland, Caithness and Angus choosing to fish the heat in Orkney. The match was run by Orkney Trout Fishing Association on behalf of SANACC, with huge thanks to Norman Irvine for weighing and measuring and Leslie Miller who did the recording and calculations to give a result in quick time, and to Paul Miller who stepped in as the Port Angler to even up the numbers.

There was a slight change of wind from South East to East, quite brisk at times but there was full cloud all of which helped the cause, providing some shelter down the east side. The middle third of the loch seemed popular for a starting point, with Ballarat, Ess Holms and Horse Shoe popular, only two boats chose to fish the open water of Biggings, all the others were fishing over skerries or on to shores.

Top rod on the day was Kevin Porteous of FNF Falcons, with a tremendous basket of 10 fish for 9lb 1oz, second was James Bews, with 8 fish for 8lb 1oz and third was Frank Watt, Shetland FFA with 8 fir 7lb 4 ozs. The match was fished to a 6 fish kill, then de-barb and catch and release. Others who found success on the day and qualification for the next round included, Brian Foreman, Stuart Leslie, Malcolm Russell, Ian Hutcheon, Kevin Imlach, Erlend Hutchison, Jim Adams, William Taylor and Ian Cannop.

Typical of Harray, there were numerous ways to catch your fish, with methods ranging from fishing Hedgehogs on a floating line to mini lures on a D17. Kevin's winning tactic was to fish the skerries and drop offs around the Ess Holms, using the FNF Arc line to great effect, short lining with the line giving the all important swoop up of the flies to the surface, it obviously made the difference. James fished mini lures on a D17 out off Biggings taking his fish on standard Orkney patterns. Others reported peach or orange flies doing the business on Midge Tips, Slow Glass lines etc.

Tight lines and every success to those who qualified, as they proceed to semi finals at various venues across Scotland.
