## Scottish Clubs Championship 2012

The following are the rules of entry to the Scottish Club Championships held at the Lake of Menteith

- 1 Clubs may now enter 2 teams of three anglers.
- 2 Total prize cheques amounts to £1250.00
- 3 All the heats are evening competitions, the Semi Finals and Final remain at 10 a.m. till 5.30p.m.
- 4 Boat seats and Thwart boards with or without back supports are allowed but due to Health & Safety requirements this may be curtailed in high winds.
- 5 Standing to fish is no longer permitted although a competitor may stand to “play” a fish or to “stretch” ones legs.
- 6 Life jackets or buoyancy aids must be worn.
- 7 It is recommended that eye protection be worn whilst fishing.

### SANACC COMPETITION RULES AS ISSUED APPLY, EXCEPT :-

Drogues are permitted.

Maximum fly size 1-1/8<sup>th</sup> inch and a Maximum hook size 3/4 inch.

Entry is restricted to SANACC members aged 16 years or over. It is now only the annual subscription to SANACC that must be paid. It is no longer necessary to be a member of SANA to enter the Scottish Club Championship. Once the competition is under way, withdrawal will incur forfeiture of entry fee.

The heats are to be fished on Saturday evenings from 5<sup>th</sup> May to 16<sup>th</sup> June and from 23<sup>rd</sup> June to 4<sup>th</sup> August. The leading 3 teams from each heat in the first group go to a Semi Final on Friday, 7<sup>th</sup> September and in the second group Friday 21<sup>st</sup> September. Fishing times during May and August are 6p.m. till 10.30p.m. and during June and July 6p.m. till 11p.m.

The Semi-Finals and Final are fished from 10.a.m. till 5.30 p.m.. Members of an unsuccessful team cannot interchange/in other words, changes can be made to a team at any stage, but **NO PERSON MAY FISH FOR MORE THAN ONE TEAM.**

The Scottish Club Championship Final will be held on Friday, 28<sup>th</sup> September, when the Trophy will be awarded to the winning team and the Silver Salver to the captor of the heaviest fish during the competition. (Both Trophies to be retained for one year)

Cash Prizes will be awarded as follows:-	1 <sup>st</sup> Place	£300.00
	2 <sup>nd</sup> Place	£200.00
	3 <sup>rd</sup> Place	£100.00
	4 <sup>th</sup> Place	£ 90.00

Thereafter reducing until the 18<sup>th</sup> team receives a cheque or the booby prize.

IN ADDITION 1<sup>st</sup> Place Team will all receive a competition fly rod,  
2<sup>nd</sup> Place Team will all receive a wide arbor fly reel,  
3<sup>rd</sup> Place Team will all receive a competition fly line

EVERY TEAM will receive prizes in form of bottles of whisky .

*In order to continue the success of the Scottish Club Championships and still give clubs in the heats value for money I am continuing as per the last six years with the initial entry fee to the competition of £60.00 per three man team, that is £20 per competitor . However due to the loss of sponsorship, club teams reaching the Semi-finals, will pay the normal day Lake of Menteith fishing fees of £69 (i.e 1 and ½ boats per team at £46 per boat). This will be the same for the final, i.e. every team will pay fishing fees of £69 per team. Every team making the final will receive a cheque.*

In the event of over subscription to the competition, clubs with 2<sup>nd</sup> teams entered may be balloted.

Breaches of the rules mean the individual may effectively have disqualified himself/herself as well as his/her team. IN ADDITION that person is precluded from any other SANACC competition for the remainder of the season, together with any other sanction the SANACC Committee may impose. It is up to every club to ensure their club members competing in the competition are aware of the necessity to adhere to the rules. A full briefing will be given prior to every heat.

Sponsorship by way of prizes will be awarded in each heat to the captain of the winning team, the angler with the heaviest basket, and the captor of the heaviest fish over 2 lbs.

Running in parallel with this competition will be the Scottish Clubs Champion of Champions 2012. The top five individual rods in each heat qualify for this contest, and the Final of the competition will be held at the Lake of Menteith on Friday, 12th October. Due to financial restrictions, the Daily Record newspaper will no longer be providing sponsorship .

As per last season all competitors qualifying for the final of the “Champion of Champions” will require to pay fishing fees of £45 . This includes the presentation meal.

Full details of the competition will continue in the “Silver Wilkie” sports column in the Daily Record. This will continue to show teams in forthcoming heats and the heat results.
